Step 4 – October 2021

1. Services and Event Management

Following the service on Sunday 10th October 2021 there will be no need to book to attend Sunday and weekday public services.

However, if there is a significant rise in Covid-19 cases Eventbrite registration will resume.

2. Entry Requirements for Public Services

Consider impact on those at high risk and how to make them feel more safe attending church.

If you feel unwell stay home. Most people with COVID-19 have mild illness and can recover at home without medical care. Do not leave your home, except to get medical care - <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/steps-when-sick.html>

We will be maintaining track & trace and it will be necessary to capture the name and contact details of all attendees.

Attendees will be able to choose where they sit.

We will continue to use the current entry and exit doors.

If any individual having attended one of our public services test positive for Covid-19 they should message the church immediately on 07722 709671.

3. Building Adjustments

There will be a phased increase in the seating capacity in the main sanctuary from Sunday 17th October 2021.

Where possible the windows will be open during meetings to bring in fresh air

4. Education & Vaccination

The restrictions are over; however the pandemic is not;

The vaccination decision is personal;

Covid-19 vaccinations do not prevent contracting or spreading the virus.

The above steps are proposed to allow us to find a balance in removing restrictions and keeping our community safe, as we move forward.
