# Fight the Good Fight of Faith – 1 Timothy 6:12

Ephesians 6:12 (read also 2 Corinthians 10:4-6)

This is not a wrestling match against a human opponent. We are wrestling with rulers, authorities, the powers who govern this world of darkness, and spiritual forces that control evil in the heavenly world. GOD'S WORD® Translation

**1. Truth** (The Word of God is Truth and is our foundation – Matthew 7:24) **Ephesians 6:13-14b** 

For this reason, take up all the armour that God supplies. Then you will be able to take a stand during these evil days. Once you have overcome all obstacles, you will be able to stand your ground. <sup>14</sup> **So then, take your stand! Fasten truth around your waist like a belt.** 

'Speak the truth in love' - Ephesians 4:15.

- a. Read the Bible everyday
  - you may try an audio Bible
  - read through the entire Bible using a plan doing it is more important than completing within a specified time period
  - try to memorise a verse you do not know.
- b. If you don't have one, buy a good study Bible
  - highlight things that speak to you
  - mark things you don't understand and pray for understanding Try a different translation alongside what you already have.
- c. Bible Commentaries are good aids you can search online for used copies
  - For Everyone Bible Study Guides by Tom Wright (New Testament Series). The first in the series is, 'Matthew for Everyone'.
  - **Tyndale Commentaries** [Old Testament & New Testament] There are 48 in the set, however they can be purchased individually.

#### **2. Faith** (Truth is linked to Faith)

Hebrews 11

## **3. Prayer** (Faith is linked to Prayer)

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18. Psalm 55:16-17; 19:14; 5:1-3; 143:1,8 We are exhorted to prayer throughout the entire Bible, so should schedule time to pray both individually and corporately.

4. Loving Service (Prayer is linked to Loving Service)

John 13:34-35, Matthew 5:44, Luke 6:27-28

Make it a priority to serve God's Kingdom.

Do good to those who hate you; pray for those who despitefully use you.

# Resolutions related to Growing In Christ:

#### 1. Work on growing in contentment

Rather than looking at what you don't have, be grateful for what you have.

# 2. Look at criticism others bring to you - a tough one!

Be open to instruction and correction when necessary, instead of reacting or making excuses.

## 3. Work on forgiveness

Pray, "Lord help me to forgive, as you have forgiven me."

## 4. Be an encourager

Magnify positives; don't focus on negatives.

# 5. Live in the reality every day, that this could be your last day before you stand before the Lord
