The Power and Dynamics of Scripture Based Prayers

When you speak God's Word over your own life, you speak and release into your own life-space the truth that God has already spoken. You release the **power of Scripture!**

- By **proclaiming** in such a way, you **honour God...by believing Him and responding** with action to His truths.
- You strengthen your own life by **overwriting negative scripts** that have driven your life for years. What a simple antidote to destructive negativity!
- Proclaiming scripture helps us understand **what God has promised us** through Jesus Christ.
- Such prayer is **part of the exercise of your royal priesthood**, on your own behalf and that of family, friends, and all that concerns you.
- It brings you to a **place of synergy: agreement with God**. You come to that place where God's Word will not return to Him void.

There is great power in this sort of prayer, because we are not just making requests to God, we are actively working with Him to implement His will in given situations.

The Weapons of Our Warfare

Thanks be to God. He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus.¹

I put on the full armour of God so that I can take my stand against the devil's schemes.

My struggle is not against flesh and blood but against the rulers, the authorities, the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.²

It is better to take refuge in the Lord than to trust in man.³ I stand firm with the belt of truth buckled around my waist⁴ for the devil is a liar and the father of lies.⁵ I put on the breastplate of righteousness.⁶

Through my faith in Jesus Christ I am made righteous before God.⁷

My feet are fitted with the readiness that comes with the gospel of peace.⁸ With my shield of faith I can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.⁹

I protect my mind and thoughts with the helmet of salvation,¹⁰ for I know the plans God has for me, plans to prosper me, plans to give me hope and a future.¹¹

The sword of the Spirit, God's Word,¹² is my weapon. With it I demolish every stronghold, argument or pretention that sets itself up against the knowledge of God.¹³ I pray with all prayers and supplication in the Spirit on all occasions, keeping alert with strong purpose and perseverance for all saints.¹⁴

In God I am more than a conqueror.¹⁵

Proclamation for Overcomers

My body is a temple for the Holy Spirit,¹⁶ redeemed,¹⁷ cleansed,¹⁸ and sanctified by the blood of Jesus.¹⁹

My members, the parts of my body, are instruments of righteousness,²⁰ yielded to God for His service and for His glory.

The devil has no place in me, no power over me, no unsettled claims against me. All has been settled by the blood of Jesus.²¹

I overcome satan by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of my testimony, and I love not my life unto the death.²²

My body is for the Lord and the Lord is for my body.²³
